All our power transformer has 3 windings for 115 - 115 and 10 volt. So you can combine by solder the winding to many different main voltages. Its simple and need not a technician. We send you a color picture from the place who are the primary transformer windings are soldered with a description what is to do. You can do it by yourself.
